2. Have experience participating in a regulatory accreditation process
3. Demonstrate a willingness to serve as a volunteer for ACCME

“The accreditation process serves a vital role in ensuring that activities and curricula which are certified for CME-credit for physicians are both independent and of high-quality, and that they improve the competence and performance of healthcare professionals, and ultimately improve patient outcomes,” said John JD Juchniewicz, MCIS, CCMEP, president of the Academy.
